Planning the Trip

Twelve pages on planning a Bangkok bachelor party, written by the people who run the nights rather than the people who visit them.

Every figure in here is for the group, with VAT inside it, and nothing is priced per person.

Where a figure belongs to The PIMP, our signature venue, it is the venue's own, confirmed with the venue, and it says so.

We are an organiser, not a venue.



ONE

What You Are Buying

One organiser holding the villa or the suite, the van, the hosts, the table and the private room.

One price for the group, VAT inside, every line shown under it.

That is the difference between a planned trip and twelve men with twelve screenshots. One person is accountable for the night, and it is not the best man.



TWO

The Four Tiers

Silver 100,000 baht: one night, a small party room, six entertainment staff.

Gold 200,000 baht: two nights, a party suite, ten entertainment staff.

Platinum 300,000 baht: three nights, the party suite, a ten-bottle package, twenty-five entertainment staff.

Diamond 450,000 baht: four nights, the same headline night, plus a six-hour pool party.

Group prices, VAT inside, nothing per person.



THREE

How Big Is the Group

Silver suits six to ten men. Gold ten to fourteen. Platinum fourteen to twenty. Diamond sixteen to thirty.

Headcount changes the logistics before it changes the price. Over eight men you are into a second vehicle, and over twenty the venue choice narrows.

So the first two questions are always the dates and the headcount, in that order.



FOUR

Where the Group Sleeps

A party-allowed villa from 18,500 baht a night is the only option that lets the party be loud at two in the morning.

A hotel suite keeps everybody central and walkable, which suits a group arriving on six different flights.

Four nights and a decent budget, and the answer is usually both: the villa for the party day, the hotel for the rest.



FIVE

The Daytime Half

A bachelor party in Bangkok is not an evening. It is a day that ends late.

A villa pool from lunchtime with hosts and a sound system is the best first thing for a group that has just landed.

Or the river: three hours on the Chao Phraya, crew and catering, up to sixteen aboard, from 48,000 baht, finishing twenty minutes from a club table.



SIX

The Night, in Order

Dinner at eight. A rooftop at nine. A club table at eleven. A private room from one.

A rooftop round for twelve runs 6,000 to 10,000 baht.

A club table carries a minimum spend rather than a ticket price. In practice a VIP zone runs 30,000 to 300,000 baht, by venue and by night.

Run it backwards and you will spend more and remember less.



SEVEN

Moving Twelve Men

A 10-hour VIP van with a driver waiting is from 6,500 baht, and over eight men you need two.

The traffic is what first-timers underestimate. A twenty-minute hop at nine is fifty minutes at seven.

The ride that is worth the whole ten hours is the one at closing time, when a group is least able to organise itself.



EIGHT

Extras That Earn Their Place

An eight-hour event host from 7,800 baht keeps a group of twelve moving, which is worth more than another bottle.

Fast-track arrival, a photographer and a bodyguard are the three extras groups ask for twice.

At The PIMP, the venue's own models and hosts start from 2,000 baht for the first hour. That figure is the venue's, confirmed with the venue.



NINE

The Private Room

The finale is a room, not another dance floor.

At The PIMP, our signature venue, the club publishes room rentals from 3,500 to 15,000 baht for the night, with a 3,000 baht per person minimum spend on food and drink for non-members.

A liquor package is 20,000 baht and bottles start at 6,000 baht. Seventeen rooms in total, including the party rooms.

Those are the venue's own figures, confirmed with the venue. We are the organiser who books them.



TEN

Money and the Deposit

An itinerary and one price come back within twenty-four hours of us having your dates and your headcount.

A card deposit confirms it. Then we run the rest, and nothing appears on the night that was not on the quote.

Nothing is per person, and VAT is inside every figure in this document.



ELEVEN

Agree These Before You Fly

Who is paying, and how the group settles up afterwards.

One name on the booking. The one night everybody has to be out for.

Who is not drinking. Who has a flight at six in the morning.

Settle those five in the group chat and the trip runs itself. Leave them and they get argued about in a van at midnight.



TWELVE

Who Runs It

One planner on the phone from the moment the group lands, a host with the group in the evening, and a driver who already has every address.

If a flight is late or a room moves, it is our problem rather than the best man's.

Send your dates and a headcount and you get the trip back in writing, with one number on it.
